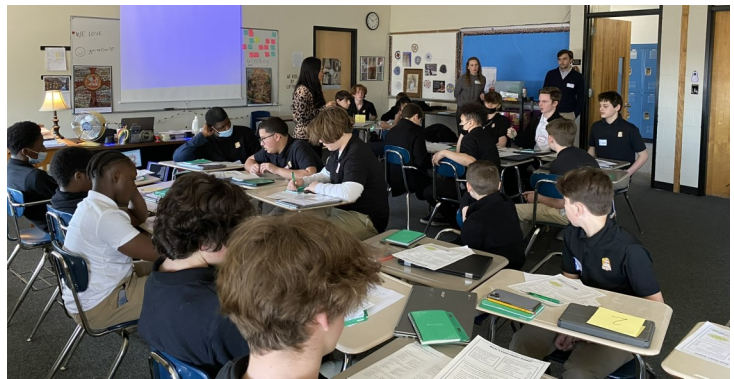

Dollar Scholar

On Tuesday March 29th, our junior high students had the unique opportunity to participate in a financial literacy program sponsored by Dollar Scholar.

Dollar Scholar is a program of the Women's Initiative of the United Way of Central MA, a volunteer-based women's group whose mission is to ignite positive change for girls, ages 10-14, through philanthropy and women's leadership. The program helps girls understand basic money management skills and provides valuable knowledge for their futures. Trained women mentors from various professions lead middle school girls through engaging activities and games around the concepts of budgeting, credit, saving, and effective decision-making. The program introduces girls to women leaders and supports their educational, career, and life plans.

Under the partnership of Country Bank and the United Way, and their giving back to the community initiative, this program has been opened to girls and boys alike. During the workshop held here at Saint Paul, our students were broken up into small groups where they discussed the ins and outs of setting financial goals for the present, as well as the future. They learned about credit scores, credit and debit cards and working a budget. They did some of this by choosing a career that interested them, found out what type of a salary that job provided, and built a living expense budget based on that salary. By the end of the workshop the kids were left with great sources of information, and a basic understanding of how to be financially successful.

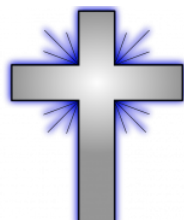
