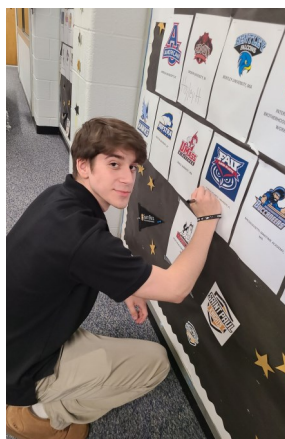
### Congratulations
