Applications for school bus transportation provided by the Worcester Public Schools for the 2022-2023 school year will continue to be accepted only through an on-line application process. Your school's unique user name and password can be found below. Completed forms will electronically record the date and time of submission. Please save the confirmation number you will receive upon successful submission of your application(s).

We recognize that all households may not have home access to a computer. As an option for those without on-line access, the Worcester Public Library main branch, as well as its satellite branches, has computers available to City residents at no charge.

Please note the list of transportation start dates based on application submission deadlines and that the on-line transportation application was re-designed for the 2019-2020 school year.

We strongly encourage you to submit a completed on-line transportation application for **each student** requesting transportation as soon as possible to assist us in creating the most efficient routes possible. Current stops will be eliminated if a new application is not received. Stops that become inactive during the school year will be eliminated to better serve those students regularly riding. 
Details are being worked out so watch for an email to come your way!


Tickets for this event will be available for purchase at the door. Cost is \$5
